

League Championship Information

- 1. All 10 teams in both Varsity & JV levels qualify for the League Championship Tournament.
- 2. Blue & Gold Division regular season champions will be the #1 and #2 seeded teams.
- 3. The #3 through #10 seeds will be seeded in order of record, regardless of division (with tie-breaking procedures used).
- 4. Seeding will go by best overall record.
- 5. Tie Break Procedures
 - a. Overall points (1 point is earned per each pairs match won by a team)
 - b. Head to head
 - c. Best non-divisional record
 - d. Overall set record (pairs)
- 6. Championships rosters must be submitted prior to the start of the tournament, and will be locked for the remainder of the playoffs. Players/pairs can change order, but cannot move between teams or levels. Alternate players may be listed beyond the 6 players, to fill in, only in case of injury.
- 7. Playoff matches will be 3 pairs, playing in order (specified teams 1, 2, 3), just like a league match. The team that wins two or more pair matches, will win the dual match.
